

Modern Languages at Crofton



The Modern Foreign Languages Faculty is a successful and ambitious part of the school, with impressive take-up and results. We are at an exciting stage of our development and are looking for an enthusiastic colleague who can offer French and German to GCSE level and is ready to embrace new ideas and technologies.

Modern Foreign Languages is one of 8 faculties. The MFL team currently consists of the Faculty Leader together with 4 other full-time and 2 part-time specialists.

Students in Year 7 start French and German in alternate years. The most able are offered a 2nd language in Year 8.

GCSE results are well above national results (84% German and 78% French) but we are determined to achieve even better.

At GCSE level, we currently follow the Edexcel syllabus and have the appropriate resources.

There is an annual exchange with the Matthias Claudias Schule in Bochum, Germany. The team also organises visits to Boulogne, Normandy and to Paris.

MFL lessons take place in a suite of five dedicated classrooms which are equipped with Interactive Smartboards.
