Saturday 7th November 2009

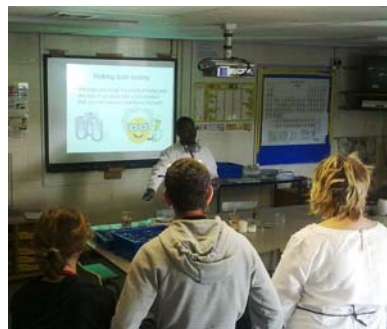
Saturday 7th November saw the first of our Saturday workshops “Chemistry is Fun”. The focus was ‘Making Hand Creams and Bath Bombs’. Firstly we had a look at what hand creams are, what are they made of, and what do they generally contain. In the other laboratory they were making Bath Bombs. What is a bath Bomb? *Fizzing treatment for the bath consisting of a combination of an acid, sodium bicarbonate, and various other ingredients.*

We then had a little teaching time that told us how they worked and what they do. Finally we were allowed to get to work and enjoyed making ourselves a treat to take home and try out in our own baths.
