- **The lockers cost £2.00 for the year, and this can be paid through ScoPay.**

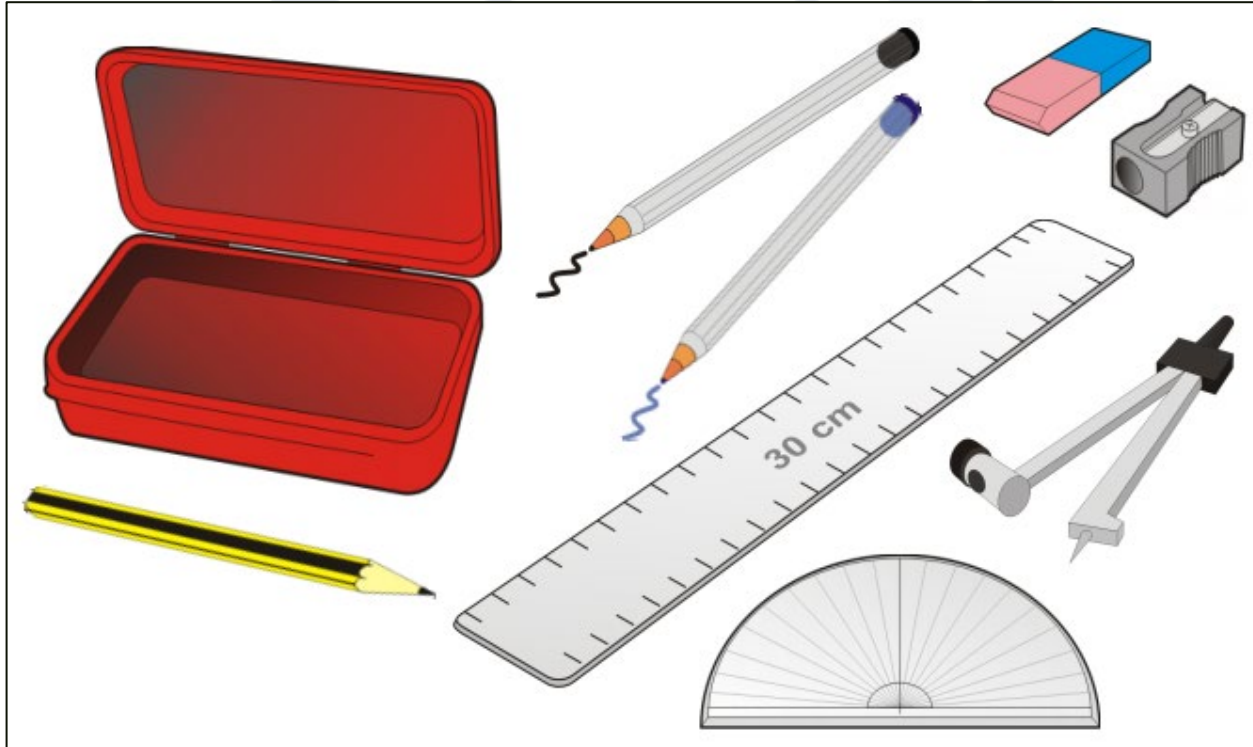

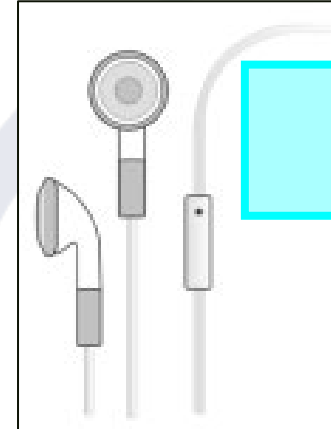

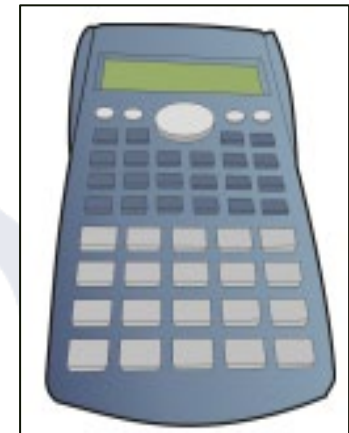
Equipment Expectations – checked daily

The School day

- Students arrive from 8.30am
- The school day starts at 8.35am. Students should be in their tutor bases at this time – self regulation/awareness task/ Crofton Expects
- Morning registration is taken at 8.45am
- Monday Tuesday Thursday and Friday the school day finishes at 3.10pm
- Wednesday timings are slightly different. Lessons are 50 minutes long and we finish at 2.05pm.

Attendance

Attendance is expected to be at 95% or above for the year.

Reading and Spelling Assessments

Why?

The reason why we are doing it on transition days is that we want to ensure all staff are ready from day 1 in September knowing information about their students to support them in the best way possible.

We want to start any interventions with students as soon as possible if students require them. The online assessments will give us that data.

We also use the data to ensure students who need additional support from the **ALG lessons** are timetabled in from September.

Parents are contacted for a meeting during July to explain what ALG is and the impact it has on students that are struggling. We can also use the data to see who our **high ability readers** are and ensure we share that with staff too to assist in planning etc.

Crofton is a school that reads and we want to encourage that from the beginning of year 7 to the end of year 11!

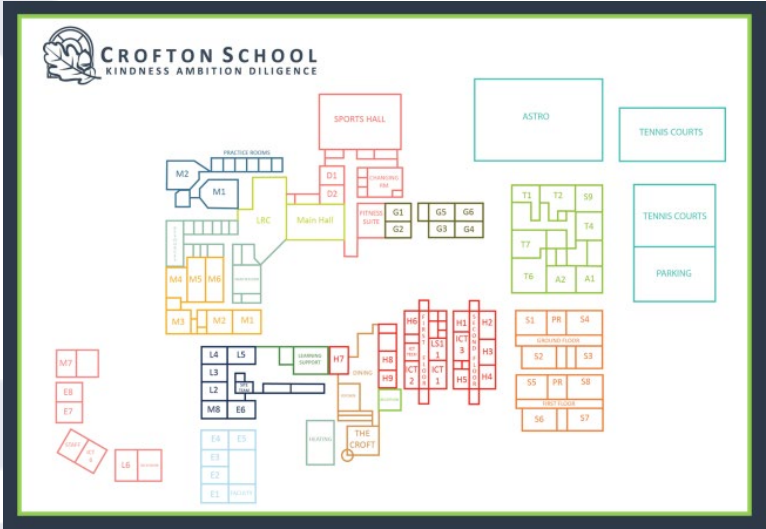

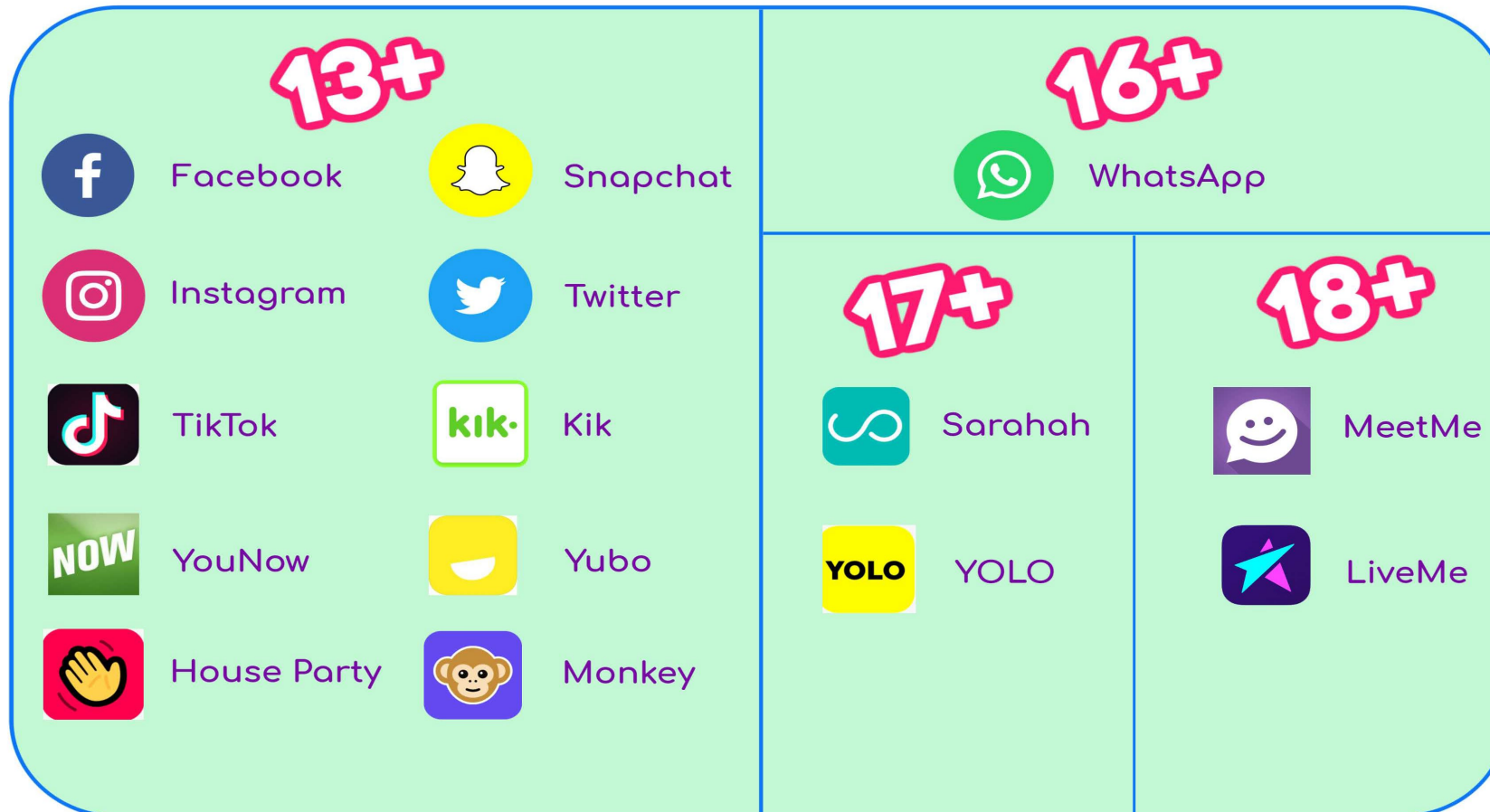

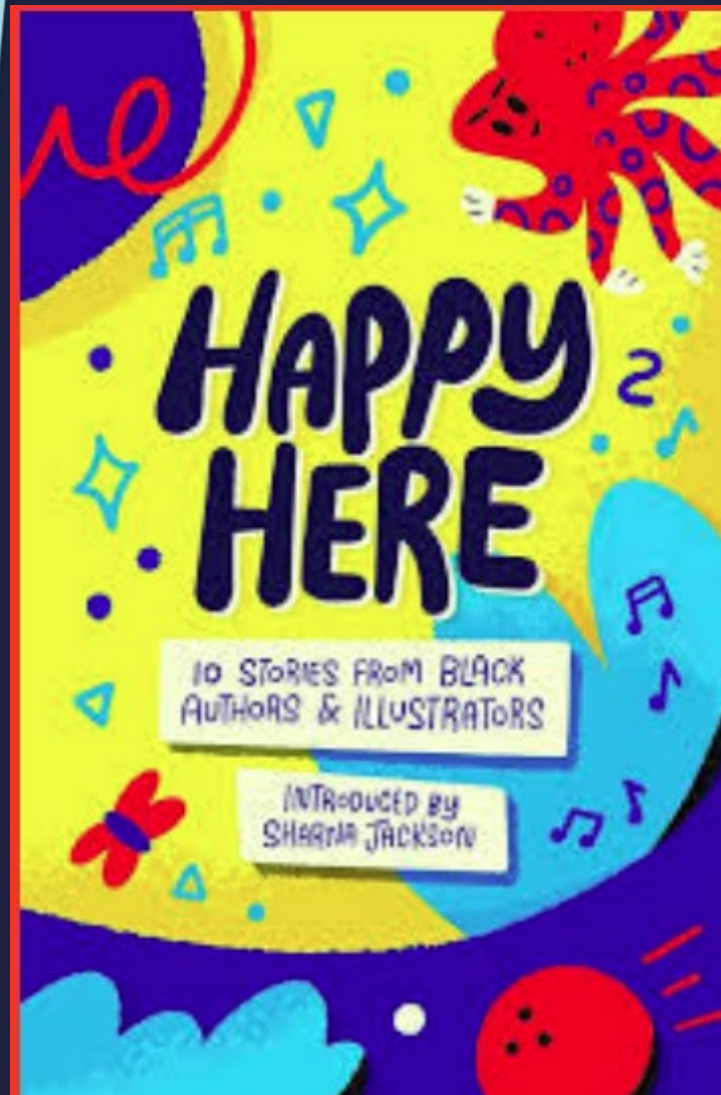
